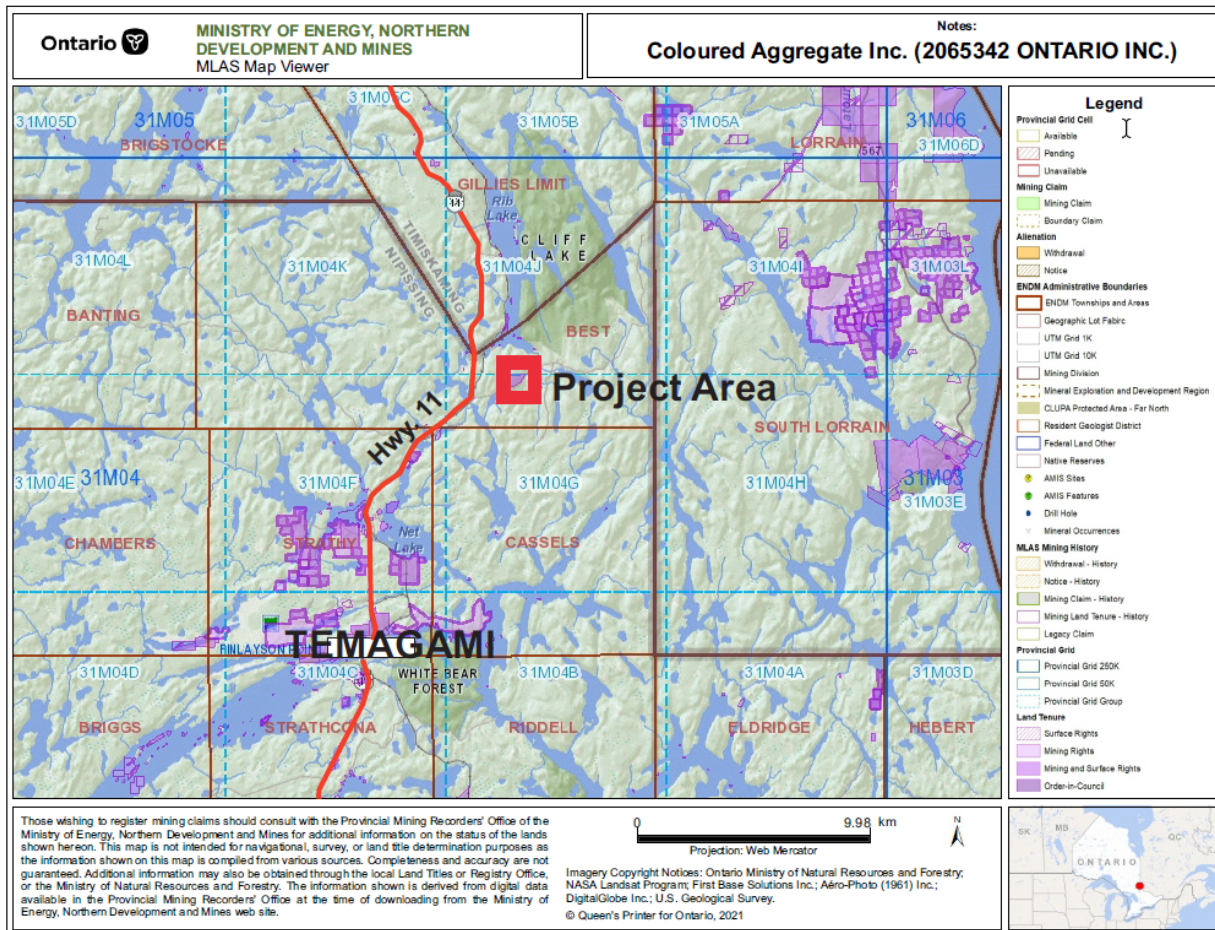
This proposed Category B project is being carried out in accordance with the Class Environmental Assessment for ENDM's Activities under the Mining Act (Class EA).
