RE: Bulk Sample Permission and Disposition Permission John R. Simpson - Granite Black Project, Mining Claim 4260811 Merrick Township, District of Nipissing

The Ministry of Northern Development and Mines (MNDM) completed its environmental assessment for John R. Simpson's proposal to remove a bulk sample of bedrock for dimension stone, and to dispose of the minerals removed on September 11, 2013.

The Category B screening, consultation and project review was carried out in accordance with the *Class Environmental Assessment for MNDM's Activities under the Mining Act* (Class EA).

Based on the Ministry of Natural Resources review of the permission, they offered the following recommendations:

- A forest resource license (FRL) is required prior to the clearing/cutting of merchantable trees if the cleared area is greater than 1 hectare on contiguous claims or over 2,500 square metres if within 100 metres of a water body,
- You should consult with Sustainable Forest Licensee as the area has been harvested and had silvicultural treatments

- Erosion/sedimentation protection may be required to keep sediment from entering waterways,
- While there are no recorded species at risk in the area of undertaking, it is the responsibility of the permittee to ensure that the proposed work does not harm, harass or kill any threatened or endangered species, or damage or destroy the habitat of any threatened or endangered species with current habitat protection,
