## Statement of Completion for a Category B Project

## Class Environmental Assessment for Activities of the Ministry of Northern Development and Mines under the Mining Act

RE: Bulk Sample Permission and Disposition Permission John R. Simpson - Granite Project, Mining Claims 4260808 and 4260809 Stewart Township, District of Nipissing

The Ministry of Northern Development and Mines (MNDM) completed its environmental assessment for John R. Simpson's proposal to remove a bulk sample of bedrock for dimension stone and to dispose of the minerals removed.

The Category B screening, consultation and project review was carried out in accordance with the *Class Environmental Assessment for MNDM's Activities under the Mining Act* (Class EA).

Based on the Ministry of Natural Resources review of the permission, they offered the following recommendations:

 A forest resource license (FRL) is required prior to the clearing/cutting of merchantable trees if the cleared area is greater than 1 hectare on contiguous claims or over 2,500 square metres if within 100 metres of a water body,

 The proponent should consult with the Sustainable Forest Licensee before undertaking the work as the area has been harvested and had silvicultural treatments:

  protection.
