Pardo Bulk Sample Project

The Ministry of Northern Development and Mines (MNDM) invites you to comment on the applicant's proposal to test the mineral content of the "Trench #1 site" on the Pardo joint venture project located approximately 65 km northeast of Sudbury, Ontario. The purpose of the "Trench #1" sampling project is to expose the boulder conglomerate beneath the upper sandstone/conglomerates. This will allow for channel sampling and other types of sampling to be performed on the targeted boulder conglomerates.

This proposed Category B project is being carried out in accordance with the Class Environmental Assessment for MNDM's Activities under the Mining Act (Class EA).
