
NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO PROVIDE INPUT ON A CATEGORY B PROJECT

Class Environmental Assessment for Activities of the Ministry of Northern Development and Mines under the Mining Act

RE: Wesdome Gold Mines Ltd. - Application for Surface Rights to Support the Proposed Tailings Management Facility

Wesdome Gold Mines Ltd. (Wesdome) invites you to comment on their proposal to apply for surface rights under Section 40 of the Mining Act for the purposes of developing a new Tailings Management Facility (TMF). Wesdome's Eagle River Mill currently processes ore from the Eagle River underground mine and from the Mishi open pit mine. A new TMF is required due to resource expansion at the mine and decreasing capacity of the existing TMF. The new TMF will be located adjacent to Wesdome's current operations. In order to construct the TMF, Wesdome has requested the addition of surface rights for the 120 m reserve surrounding a portion of an unnamed tributary of Macassa Creek and a small portion of land at the southern end of the unnamed tributary to its existing lease (refer to the figure below).

This proposed **Category B** project is being carried out in accordance with Ministry of Northern Development and Mines' (MNDM) *Class Environmental Assessment for MNDM's Activities under the Mining Act* (Class EA).
