### MLAS Release 2.5.20 System Upgrade Alert

As part of our ongoing efforts to bring you one of the most comprehensive mining lands management systems in the world, the Ministry of Northern Development, Mines, Natural Resources and Forestry regularly tests and installs updated versions of the Mining Lands Administration System (MLAS).

The following applications and functions have been recently improved or implemented:

#### Assessment Work Updates

- Notice of Determination letters are now generated through MLAS. The Assessment Work Manager and the tenure holder will receive an email from MLAS. Clients who receive a Notice of Determination can rectify the issues through their MLAS account under the Work Reporting tab, then under Revise Report of Work Submission.
- We have made improvements to the workflow screens for Assessment Work Reporting for greater clarity.
- We have made improvements to the user selections in all assessment reporting forms. e.g. filtering of claims, pasting, repetitiveness has been reduced, etc.

#### Map Viewer

- We have made improvements for several functions such as Zoom to Search Coordinates, and Distance and Area Tool units now default to hectares and metres.
- The labels for the Mining Land Tenure Layers are now scalable and on by default.
- We have added additional projection options to the Upload Data Tool.
- Complete mining claim abstracts can now be generated through MLAS map viewer.
- Map Viewer Alienation History Symbology has been revised.

**Please note:** We have enhanced several internal administrative functions and made mapping operation improvements to help staff members provide better customer service.
