



MLAS Release 2.5.28.2 System Upgrade Alert

As part of our ongoing efforts to bring you one of the most comprehensive mining lands management systems in the world, the Ministry of Energy and Mines regularly tests and installs updated versions of the Mining Lands Administration System (MLAS).

The following MLAS applications and functions have been improved or implemented:

1. Summary of Credit Distribution Events on Abstracts

Claim Distribution events are now consolidated for improved clarity. Each distribution event may generate up to three entries on a tenure abstract:

- **Credit Applied** – The total amount applied to the claim during the distribution event.
- **Credit Distributed** – The total credit transferred from this claim's/tenure's reserve to other claims
- **Credit Withdrawn** – The total credit removed from this claim's/tenure's reserve

2. Improved Data Retention When Using the Back Button in Distribution Functions

You can now navigate between pages without losing your work when filing a Distribution of Approved Credits or Pending Distribution.

- If no changes are made on the previous page, your data remains unchanged.
- If changes are made, only the affected fields will update; all other data will remain unchanged.

Important Notes:

- If you exit the submission without saving your draft, your work may be lost.
- This enhancement applies only to the **Back button within the MLAS** application. Using the browser Back button will still result in data loss.

3. Increased Limits in Various Components

- Submit assessment work reports - up to 1,000 tenures at one time
- Pending distribution - up to 1,000 additional claims
- Exclusion of time request - up to 1,000 tenures.

4. Enhanced Text Boxes for Inputting tenure numbers

- Automatically removes duplicates
- Numerically sorts claim numbers
- Shows a count of inputted tenures

5. Client Profile Link Fixed

The issue with the client profile link for contact information has been resolved. It now functions correctly on the claim abstract page in the Public Map Viewer

6. Following Directives have been updated
