MLAS Release 2.5.22 System Upgrade Alert

Ontario is working to create one of the most comprehensive mining lands management systems in the world. As part of this work, the Ministry of Mines regularly updates the Mining Lands Administration System (MLAS).

The following applications and functions have been improved or implemented:

Client management updates:

- Search tenures and display enhancements have been made to the Manage Agents and View Agent Status features.
- More information, including client name and a link to the event detail have been added to View Event Details on the Bulletin Board.

Assessment work updates:

• The Multiple Submissions feature has been fixed to display the Transaction ID and Work Report ID for selection. This correction applies to both Submit Report of Work and Submit Report of Work on Crown Land.

Map viewer:

- **New** Plans and Permits tools: dataset layer added, link to detailed documents, and enhanced query options.
- Zoom to Features menu has been expanded into Find a Location and Find a Mining Lands Location, and the display has been improved.
- Abandoned Mines Information and Drill Hole data have been refreshed.
- Mineral Deposit Inventory data, including re-labelling Mineral Occurrences to Ontario Mineral Inventory, have been updated.
- Drawing Order has been improved with Alienations, having a visible transparency layer over mining lands data.
- The Map Viewer display has been enhanced to be more user friendly.
