



MLAS Release 2.5.23 System Upgrade Alert

Ontario is working to create one of the most comprehensive mining lands management systems in the world. As part of this work, the Ministry of Mines regularly updates the Mining Lands Administration System (MLAS).

The following applications and functions were recently improved or implemented:

Claim Acquisition updates:

- The process for registering a mining claim has been revised to enhance security. You will now find the CAPTCHA step located at step three of the Register a Mining Claim process.
- A hyperlink is now included in the review and agreement section of the ministry's Terms of Use for MLAS's Claim Acquisition and Map Viewer's disclaimer page to Terms of Use for accessing and using government webpages.
- Directive 3: Registering a Mining Claim has been revised to include the updates in MLAS.
- No browser add-ons or automated systems such as scripts, spiders, offline readers, bots, or any other enhanced tools may be used in the selection of cells for registration or in the registration of mining claims. Users also may not use any such scripts or programs to manipulate or interfere with the proper functioning of MLAS. The use of such scripts or programs may result in the entry of the mining claim being deleted from the mining claims registry.

Reports:

- There have been several updates to the MLAS Client Report:
 - Multiple Legacy Claim IDs (if applicable) have been grouped together in a comma-separated list for converted claims to avoid the duplication of Tenure IDs.
 - All active tenures registered to a holder will be displayed, including Leases, Patents, MLOs, and ELOs.

- The adjusted Due Date will now display if different from the Anniversary Date to clearly indicate a claim's current work assessment requirement due date.
 - Now includes the number of cells and hectares.
 - Work Applied has been changed to Total Work Applied - This refers to the total amount of work that has been previously applied to the claim.
 - The Yearly and Available Assessment Assignment amounts are now displayed.
 - A Work Report Pending indicator has been added.
 - Registered Holders names are now displayed.
 - The Mining Division has been added.
 - The Conversion Bank Credit column has been removed.
- Township Reports can now be searched for a Licence of Occupation.

Search menu:

- Search filters have been enhanced.
- Search Public Abstracts is now called Search Licence of Occupation.
- Users may now print abstracts for licences of occupation from the Search Licence of Occupation menu and from the Map Viewer.

Please note: Several other internal administrative functions and mapping operations have been improved to help us provide better customer service.
