

ORDER

SECTION 35, THE MINING ACT, R.S.O. 1990

ORDER NO. W-TB-05/18

The SURFACE RIGHTS and MINING RIGHTS of the areas outlined in red on the attached sketch, situated in the Township of Pearson (G-0682), Thunder Bay Mining Division, containing 24.9 hectares more or less, are hereby WITHDRAWN from prospecting, staking out, sale or lease.

These areas are WITHDRAWN while the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry completes the land use amendment and boundary regulation processes for the additions to the Pearson Township Recommended Conservation Reserve.

Saving, excepting and reserving hereto and herefrom, all other lands patented, sold, leased or otherwise alienated by the Crown at the date of this Order.

Any alienated lands lying within the limits of these withdrawn areas that revert to the Crown subsequent to the date of this Order will automatically be considered to be withdrawn as part of this Order.

This order comes into effect upon signing.

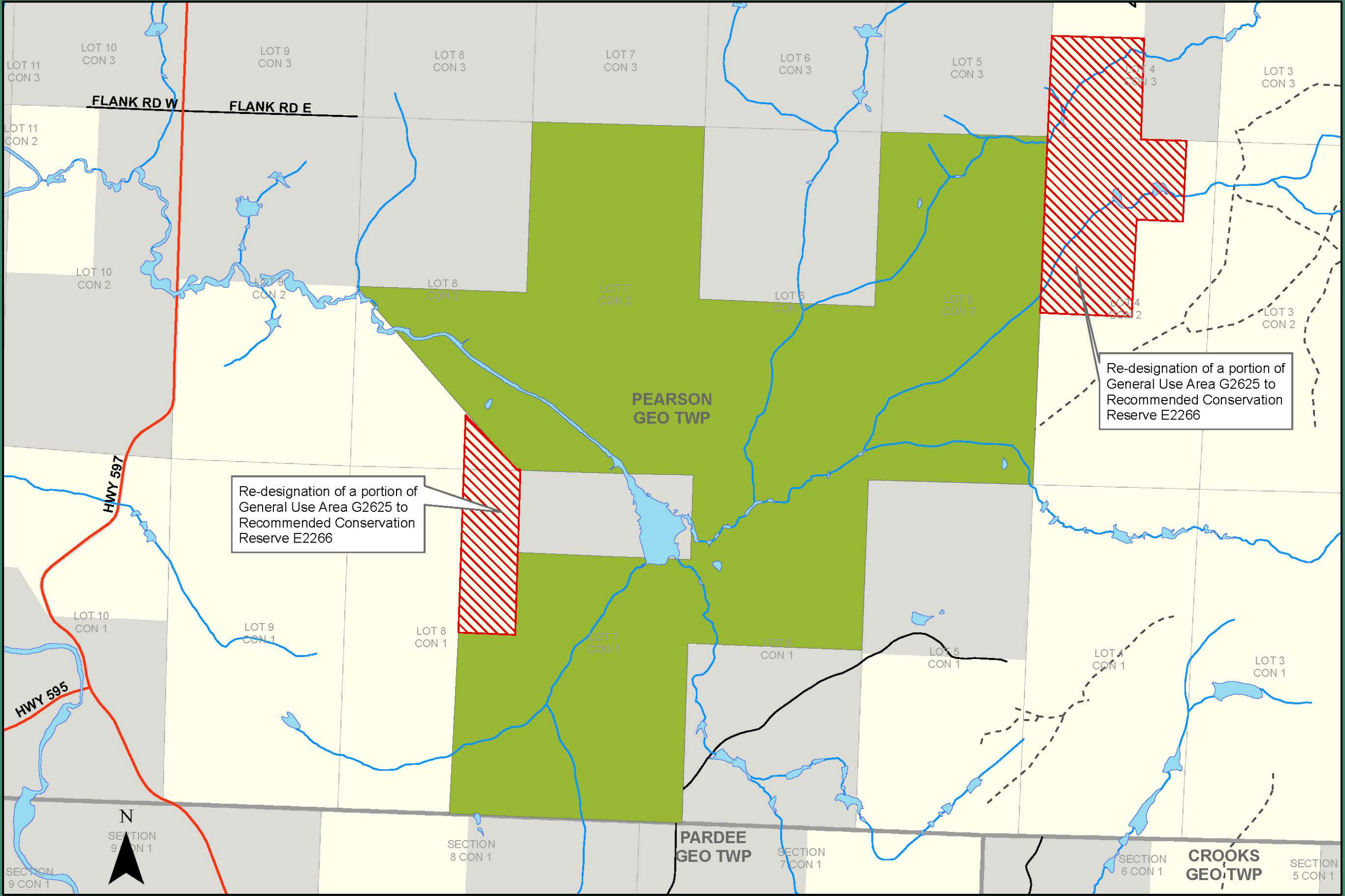
