SECTION 35, THE MINING ACT, R.S.O. 1990

ORDER NO. W-TB-88/09

The SURFACE and MINING RIGHTS of the area outlined on the attached sketch consisting of Parts 1 to 23, situated in Lahontan Township (G-0629) and Middle Fox Lake Area (G-0085) in the Thunder Bay Mining Division, containing 1770 hectares, more or less, are hereby WITHDRAWN from prospecting and staking out, sale or lease. The area is withdrawn in order to settle land and Larger Land Base negotiations with the Pays Plat First Nation.

Saving, excepting and reserving hereto and herefrom, all other lands patented, sold, leased or otherwise alienated by the Crown at the date of this Order.

Any alienated lands lying within the limits of this withdrawn area that revert to the Crown subsequent to the date of this Order will automatically be considered to be withdrawn as part of this Order.

This order comes into effect on Friday, July 17, 2009 at 12:01:01 a.m..




